This Indenture made this second day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty four between J. S. Davis and Elvada Davis his wife of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and Mary Lamberton of the second part;

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Dollars to them duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit;

Beginning on South side Warren Street extended West from City of Lawrence 834 1/2 feet West of a point 320.00 Rods West of Block 10 Lane's Second Addition to City of Lawrence West along South side said Warren Street extended 14 1/2 feet South - 348 1/2 feet East 74 1/2 feet North 48 1/2 feet to beginning, with the appurtenances and all the estate title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said J. S. Davis does hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof he is the lawful owner of the premises above granted and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances. This grant is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of One Thousand Dollars according to the terms of one certain promissory note this day
