

This Indenture, Made this twenty eighth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty four between George G. Johnson and Matilda H. Johnson his wife of the Township of Wakarusa in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and Hiram M. Northrup of Wyandotte Kansas of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred Dollars to them duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit:

The North east quarter of the south east quarter of Section No. Ten (10) in Township No. Thirteen (13) south of Range No. Twenty (20) east of the 6" principal meridian containing 40 acres more or less with the appurtenances and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said George G. Johnson does hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof he is the lawful owner of the premises above granted and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to receive the payment of the sum of Seven hundred dollars on or before five (5) years after date with interest at Eight per centum according to the terms of two certain notes and coupons this day executed and delivered by the said George G. Johnson to the said party of the second part, one note being for three hundred
