Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Dollars to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows to wit:

Lot No. One North East Central Sub-division of the N. West Quarter of South West Quarter of Section No. Twenty nine Township No 12 South of Range No. 20 East of 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. Kansas in that part of the City of Lawrence formerly North Lawrence with the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said Grantors do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Two Hundred Dollars in Twelve months after date with interest at 10% from date until paid according to the terms of one certain note the day executed and delivered by the said Smallwoods.
