Miller party of the second part her heirs and assigns the real estate hereinafter described situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas to wit;

The South half of the North West Quarter of Section number Five (5) Town number Thirteen (13) Range number nineteen (19) East of the Sixth P.M. and containing eighty (80) acres more or less. To secure the said party of the second part for an actual loan of money made to the said Jackson Strahan and Mary J. Strahan as evidenced by one certain Bond No. ninety six hundred and seventy seven of Four Hundred Dollars of even date herewith in and by which said bond the party of the first part promise to pay to the order of Lizzie J. Miller in lawful money of the United States of America the principal sum of Four Hundred Dollars three years after date thereof
