Moore his wife of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas party of the first part and The Mutual Benefit Life Insurance Company of the County of Essex and State of New Jersey party of the second part;

Witnesseth That the said party of the first part in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred Dollars to the said party of the first part by the said party of the second part in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do by these presents grant bargain and sell unto the said party of the second part and its heirs executors administrators and assigns certain land or real estate situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas and more particularly bounded and described as follows to wit;
