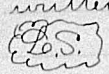

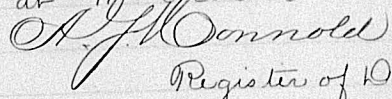

This Indenture, made this twenty seventh day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty five between George F. Stevens and Amelia J. Stevens his wife of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and Martin Gilmore of Cambridge New York of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Seventeen hundred Dollars to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit:

The south half of the north half and the east thirty five acres of the south half of the south east quarter of Section (7) seven, township (12) twelve, Range (20) twenty containing (75) seventy five acres more or less with the appurtenances and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein.
