Witnesseth That the said party of the first part in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars to the said party of the first part by the said party of the second part in hand paid who the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do by these presents grant bargain and sell unto the said party of the second part and to its heirs executors administrators and assigns certain land or real estate situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas and more particularly bounded and described as follows to wit The North half of the South West quarter of Section No. One (1) in Township No. Fourteen (14) South of Range No. Twenty one (21) East of the Sixth P.M. containing eighty (80) acres more or less.
