This Indenture, Made this First day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty Five.

Witnesseth, that John Wise and Katie Wise Husband and wife of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas party of the first part, for and in consideration of Twelve Hundred Dollars, convey and Warrants to Henry Dickinson party of the second part his heirs and assigns, the real estate hereinafter described, situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas to wit:

The West half of the South West quarter of Section number Twenty eight :28; Town number Twelve :12; Range number Twenty :20; East of the Sixth :6; P. M. and containing Eighty :80; acres more or less.

To secure the said party of the second part for an actual loan of money made to the said John Wise and Katie Wise as evidence by one certain Bond No. Ten Thousand Five Hundred and Seven of Twelve Hundred Dollars of even date herewith, in and by which said bond the party of the first part promise to pay to the order of Henry Dickinson in lawful money of the United States of America, the principal sum of Twelve Hundred Dollars Three years after date thereof with interest thereof at the rate of seven per centum per annum interest payable semi-annually, according to and upon presentation of interest coupons therefor thereunto attached, both principal and interest being payable at the National Bank of Commerce, in New York City.

Also Providing, that in case any interest or any of said sums shall remain unpaid for ten days after the same becomes due, then the entire sum covered by said bond and secured by this Mortgage Deed, to become immediately due and payable without any notice of any kind whatsoever, and same to be collected in like manner as if the full time provided in said bond had expired.

It is Further Expressly Agreed, That the first party shall at all times keep the taxes and assessments of any and all kinds that may become liens upon said premises fully paid and satisfied, and that said security shall remain and be kept as good as the same is now during the continuance of this loan.
