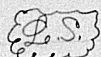

Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Three hundred + fifty Dollars to him duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has sold and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows to wit: Lots number thirteen (13) and fourteen (14) on Adams Street in Steel's Sub-division of Block number Eight (8) in the City of Lawrence with the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said party of the first part therein.
