West ten (10) acres of Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Fifteen (15), and west thirty-five (35) acres of South Half (S $\frac{1}{2}$) of Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Fifteen (15); all in Township Fourteen (14) South, Range Twenty (20) East of the Sixth Principal Meridian;

Containing 45 acres, more or less, according to the U. S.
Government Survey thereof.

Together with all privileges, hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, including all water, irrigation and drainage rights of every kind and description, however evidenced or manifested, and all rights of way, apparatus and fixtures belonging to or used in connection therewith, whether owned by the Mortgagor at the date of this mortgage, or thereafter acquired.

That said above granted premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances whatsoever, ~~excepting~~

Provided, this mortgage is given to secure the payment by the Mortgagor to the Mortgagee, at his offices in the City of Wichita, Kansas, of the sum of \$ 800.00, evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, executed by the Mortgagor to the Mortgagee, conditioned for the payment of said sum, with interest on said principal or unpaid balance thereof at the rate of five per centum per annum, payable semi-annually on the 1st day of December and June in each year; said principal sum being payable on an amortization plan and in forty (40) equal, successive semi-annual installments of \$ 20.00 each, the first instalment being payable on the 1st day of December, 1940, and the remaining instalments being payable on each succeeding interest payment date, to and including the 1st day of June, 1960; Mortgagor to have the privilege, of paying at any time one or more instalments of principal, or the entire unpaid balance of said principal sum, such additional principal payments, if made, operating to discharge the debt secured hereby at all times and not affecting the amount or the due date of any of the payments payable in instalments of principal.

The Mortgagor does hereby covenant and agree with the Mortgagee, as follows:

1. To by now lawfully seized of the free simple title to all of said above described real estate; to have good right to sell and convey the same; that the same is free from all encumbrances excepting such encumbrances as are specifically described and set out herein; and to warrant and defend the title thereto against the lawful claims or demands of all persons whatsoever.
2. To pay when due all payments provided for in the note secured hereby.
3. To make return of said real estate for taxation, when so required by law; to pay before they become delinquent all taxes, charges and assessments lawfully levied against the property hereby conveyed; and to exhibit to Mortgagee receipts, or certified copies thereof, evidencing such payment.
4. To pay at all times during the existence of this mortgage all due sums and interest on any mortgage, judgment, lien or encumbrance senior to or on this mortgage; to pay the principal debt secured by such mortgage, judgment, lien or encumbrance when due; to exhibit to Mortgagee receipts, or certified copies thereof, evidencing such payment; and to perform all other covenants and conditions contained in any such mortgage, judgment, lien or encumbrance senior to the lien of this mortgage.
