This Indenture, made this 12th day of April A.D. 1928 by and between Continental National Bank and Trust Company of Chicago, a national banking association, as successor trustee to Continental and Commercial Trust and Savings Bank, a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Illinois, (hereinafter sometimes termed the "Trustee") party of the first part, and Elmerdale Oil Company, a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Delaware (hereinafter sometimes termed the "Company") party of the second part,

Witnesseth, Whereas the Company did by a certain Trust Indenture, dated as of the 1st day of June A.D. 1919 convey and mortgage to Continental and Commercial Trust and Savings Bank, as Trustee, upon the trusts set out in said Trust Indenture, all the property, rights and franchises of the Company whether owned at the time of the execution of said Trust Indenture or thereafter acquired, in order to secure the payment of its First Mortgage Bonds to an aggregate principal amount of Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000) par value at any time outstanding, said bonds bearing date June 1, 1919 and being payable June 1, 1929; which said Trust Indenture was filed for record in the office of the Register of Deeds of each of the counties hereinafter named on the respective dates set opposite the names of said respective counties, and was recorded in said respective offices in the books and at the pages set forth opposite the names of said respective counties, to-wit:
