Parcel No. 109. Tarrant County.

A part of Lot One (1) of the Jergen Greve Addition to the City of Ft. Worth, Texas described as follows:

Beginning at a point One Hundred and Fifty (150) feet South and Sixteen (16) feet West of the original Northeast corner of said Lot One (1), said beginning point being in the West line of a Sixteen (16) foot strip off of the East side of said Lot One (1) conveyed to the City of Polytechnic for street purposes by Joe S.
