

Parcel No. 123. Williamson County.

Lots Nine (9) and Ten (10), Block Twenty (20) of the City of Taylor, Williamson County, Texas, fronting one hundred and four (104) feet on the East line of Vance Street and running back East one hundred twenty-five (125) feet along the North Line of Olive or Fourth Street to an alley.

WEST VIRGINIA.

Parcel No. 124. Mercer County.

All that tract or parcel of land lying and being in the City of Blue field, County of Mercer, West Virginia, and known as the Northern part of Section 155, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the North side of a ten (10) foot wide alley with the west side of Poplar Street, a distance of one hundred thirty (130) feet North of the intersection of the North side of Bluefield Avenue with the west side of said Poplar Street; thence South sixty-two degrees (62°) forty-three minutes (43') West along the North side of said alley, three hundred (300) feet, more or less, to the east side of Beech Street; thence North twenty-seven degrees (27°) seventeen minutes (17') West, along the East side of Beech Street, one hundred forty-five (145) feet more or less, to a point in the South line of the right of way of the Norfolk & Western Railway Company; thence in a Northerly direction, along the said right of way of the Norfolk & Western Railway Company, three hundred one and thirty-five (301.35) feet, more or less, to the West side of Poplar Street; thence South twenty-seven degrees (27°) seventeen minutes (17') East along the West side of Poplar Street, one hundred seventy-three (173) feet more or less, to the point of beginning, and being the same property which was conveyed to American Service Company by Bluefield Ice & Cold Storage Company, a corporation, by a deed dated Dec. 4, 1928, and recorded in the office of the Clerk of the County Court of Mercer County, West Virginia, in Deed Book 193, page 333.

Parcel No. 125. Mercer County.

All that tract or parcel of land lying and being in the City of Princeton, County of Mercer, State of West Virginia, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the south line of Straley Avenue with the West line of North Third Street; thence with the West line of North Third Street South eight degrees (8°) thirty-nine minutes (39') East one hundred seventy-seven (177) feet to the North line of an alley; thence with said alley N. eighty-eight degrees (88°) twenty-one minutes (21') W. one hundred thirteen and eight tenths (113.8) feet to the middle line of a brick wall on the dividing line between the property hereby conveyed and the property of E. A. Hannah, known as the Chero Cola Bottling Works; thence with the middle line of said wall, and extending beyond the end thereof in a straight line, N. ten degrees (10°) four one hundredths minutes (.04') W. one hundred fifty-seven and three tenths (157.3) feet to the South line of Straley Avenue; thence with the South line of Straley Avenue North eight-one degrees (81°) twenty-one minutes (21') E. one hundred twelve and nineteen one hundredths (112.19) feet to the point of beginning, being the Eastern end of Lots Nos. ninety-seven (97), ninety-eight (98), ninety-nine (99), one hundred (100) and one hundred one (101) of Section one hundred twenty-one (121) of the City of Princeton (known as Block No. Six (6) of section No. One (1) on the map of the Prince Addition to said City).

VIRGINIA

Parcel 126. Washington County.

All that tract or parcel of land lying and being in the City of Bristol, County of Washington, Virginia, and more particularly described as follows:

A certain tract of land situate in Bristol, Virginia, and described as follows:

Beginning at a stake on the North side of Euclid Avenue, which point is eighty (80) feet Southwest of the Northwest corner of Euclid and Commonwealth Avenues, and running thence in a Southwesterly direction with line of Euclid Avenue projected (now closed) one hundred twenty-eight and nine-tenths (128.9) feet to a stake thirty (30) feet from the center of the main line of the Southern Railway Company; which stake is on the right of way line of the Southern Railway; thence in a Northerly direction with the right of way of the Southern Railway Company and thirty (30) feet distant from its center line one hundred (100) feet to a stake; thence continuing with said Southern Railway Company's right of way and thirty (30) feet distant from the center of the main line ninety-nine (99) feet to a stake, corner to the property of Rader; thence East with Rader's line one hundred sixty-three (163) feet to a stake, corner of property of R. F. Wagner; thence South with Wagner's line one hundred sixty-eight and four tenths (168.4) feet to the point of beginning, and being the same property conveyed by Bristol Coal & Ice Company, Inc., to American Service Company by deed dated Nov. 27, 1928, and of record in Deed Book 47, page 467 in the Clerk's Office of Bristol, Virginia.

Parcel 127. Washington County.

A certain tract of land described as follows:

Beginning at a stake on the West side of Piedmont Street corner to the land of the Southern Railway Company; thence North with said Piedmont Street 154 feet to a stake, corner of property of the City of Bristol, Virginia; thence with line of the City of Bristol, Va. in a Northwesterly direction 229.2 feet to a stake on the Southeast side of King Street; thence Southwest with said King Street 73 feet to a stake, corner to property of the Southern Railway Company; thence in a Southeasterly direction with line of the Southern Railway Company 337.9 feet to the point of beginning, and being the same property conveyed to Bristol Coal & Ice Company, Inc. by the Goodwyn Coal & Ice Company, Inc. by deed dated June 10, 1925, and of record in D. R. 41 page 256 in said Clerk's Office, to which deed as well as to said deed of May 15, 1924, from the said R. F. Wagner and wife reference is here had for a more particular description of the two properties herein conveyed.

CLAUSE B.

All shares of capital stock and bonds, notes or other obligations of any corporation or corporations, or of any government or state or any political subdivision thereof or of any municipality, which shall at any time or from time to time hereafter be pledged with the Trustees or required to be by any of the provisions hereinafter in this Indenture contained.

CLAUSE C.

Any and all property of every name and nature which from time to time after the execution and delivery of this Indenture by delivery or by writing of any kind for the purposes hereof shall have been conveyed, mortgaged, pledged, assigned or transferred by the Company, or by any one on its behalf or with its consent, to the Trustees, which are hereby authorized to receive at any and all times any property as and for additional security for the payment of the bonds issued or to be issued under this Indenture.
