APPOINTMENT OF TRUSTEE

That, Whereas, The Kansas City Long Distance Telephone Company, a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of Missouri, by its certain indenture deed of trust made and entered into January 18, 1905, and recorded in the office of the Recorder of Deeds in and for Jackson County, Missouri, in Book B-937, Page 131, conveyed to the Commonwealth Trust Company, also a Missouri corporation, the property rights and franchises of the said Telephone Company all particularly described in the said deed of trust; and

WHEREAS, it is provided by the terms of said indenture that in case there shall at any time be a vacancy in the office of said Trustee, either by resignation or otherwise, the Telephone Company may appoint as a new Trustee any Trust Company incorporated under the laws of the State of Missouri to act until a new Trustee shall be appointed by the bondholders; and

WHEREAS, the said Commonwealth Trust Company did, on the 12th day of November, 1915, resign as Trustee under said mortgage; and

WHEREAS, no trustee has been appointed by said bondholders; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the said Telephone Company did by resolution, authorize and direct its officers to make and appoint the Commerce Trust Company of Kansas City, Missouri, Trustee under said indenture and to succeed the said Commonwealth Trust Company;
