and having its principal office and place of business in the City of Kansas City and State of Missouri, made, executed, and acknowledged its First Mortgage Deed of Trust (hereinafter sometimes referred to as "Trust Indenture") wherein certain property, real and personal, therein described and certain other property therein referred to was transferred and conveyed, and said Trust Indenture delivered to COMMONWEALTH TRUST COMPANY, a corporation, existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Missouri and having its principal place of business in the City of St. Louis, State of Missouri, as Trustee, in trust to secure the payment of an issue of First Mortgage Five Per Cent Gold Bonds in the aggregate principal sum of \$1,500,000 and certain interest coupons attached thereto, all as more fully described and set out in said Trust Indenture, which Indenture is of public record; and

WHEREAS, the undersigned Commerce Trust Company, a corporation existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Missouri, and having its principal office and place of business in the City of Kansas City, Missouri, has succeeded to all the rights, powers and duties of said Commonwealth Trust Company, as Trustee, by virtue of a certain supplemental indenture of appointment as Successor Trustee, dated December 17, 1915, duly created and executed under and by virtue of the provisions of said Trust Indenture, and as such Successor Trustee is entitled to and is exercising all the powers granted in said Trust Indenture to the said Commonwealth Trust Company; and certified copy of said supplemental indenture is attached and made a part hereof, marked exhibit "A".

WHEREAS, all the bonds and all the coupons appertaining thereto at any time issued and outstanding under and secured by said Trust Indenture and said Indenture supplemental thereto have been paid and duly cancelled and said Kansas City Long Distance Telephone Company, its successors and assigns, if any have become and are entitled to a release and discharge of the lien of said Trust Indenture and Indenture supplemental thereto upon property therein described and referred to and thereby encumbered; NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the premises, and the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) to the undersigned in hand paid, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and pursuant to the request of said Kansas City Long Distance Telephone Company, the undersigned, Commerce Trust Company, the present Trustee, as aforesaid, does hereby remise, convey, release and forever quitclaim unto said Kansas City Long Distance Telephone Company, its successors and assigns, all right, title and interest which the undersigned Trustee has or may have acquired under and by virtue of said Trust Indenture and Indenture supplemental thereto in and to the real and personal property therein described or referred to, and does hereby further forever release and discharge the lien, created under and by virtue of said Trust Indenture, and the Indenture supplemental thereto, on all property, real and personal, therein transferred and conveyed to the Trustee thereunder by specific description or otherwise. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto said KANSAS CITY LONG DISTANCE TELEPHONE COMPANY, its successors and assigns, free, and clear and discharged of and from all liens, claims and effects under and by virtue of said Trust Indenture and said Indenture supplemental thereto.
