EXTENSION AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, there now remains unpaid on a certain note executed and delivered by William G. Wright, a widower, to The Prudential Insurance Company of America, secured by a mortgage upon real estate in Douglas County, Kansas, dated February 24th 1926 recorded in said County on March 5th 1926 in Volume 69 of mortgages on Page 365 the sum of Forty Three Hundred Dollars, with interest from February 24th 1931 and

WHEREAS, Title to the mortgaged premises is now vested in William G. Wright, a widower, subject to said mortgage and

WHEREAS, the said Insurance Company has been requested to make said note payable as hereinafter agreed, which it has consented to do in consideration of the payments to be made as herein provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, the said William G. Wright, a widower, hereby agrees to pay the principal sum remaining due as aforesaid as follows: Forty three hundred dollars on or before seven years from February 24, 1931 in semi-annual payments of One hundred dollars, payable on the 24th day of August and February of each year, beginning with the 24th day of August 24, 1931 and one payment of Three thousand Dollars, payable on the 24th day of February 1938 with interest thereon from February 24th 1931 to February 24th 1938 at the rate of five and one-half per cent per annum, payable semi-annually; and with interest after maturity as set forth in said note.

PREPAYMENT PRIVILEGE: Privilege if given to make additional payments of \$100.00 or multiples thereof on account of principal on any interest paying date.

And the parties to this agreement hereby consent to said extension and agree that said mortgage shall continue a first lien upon said premises, and that said note and mortgage and all their covenants and conditions shall remain in force except as herein modified.
