WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of \$1,200.00 Twelve Hundred & No/100 DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do GRANT, BARGAIN, SELL and MORTGAGE to the said parties of the second part their heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows, to-wit:

North one-half of the Northwest Quarter of Section Five (5), Township Fifteen (15), Range Twenty-One (21).

with the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all encumbrances excepting mortgage of \$2,000.00 to the Equitable Life Assurance Society.

THIS GRANT is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of \$1,200.00 Twelve Hundred & No/100 DOLLARS, according to the terms of a certain mortgage note or bond, this day executed by the said parties of the first part, and payable on the 28nd day of December, 1935, to the order of said second party its heirs or assigns, with interest at the rate of 5%, payable annually. First interest payment date to be August 2nd, 1932 and annually thereafter. And this conveyance shall be void if such payment be made as is herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or if the taxes on said land are not paid when the same become due and payable, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, as provided herein, or if the buildings are not kept in good repair, or if the improvements are not kept in good condition, or if waste is committed on said premises, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole sum remaining unpaid shall immediately become due and payable, at the option of the holder hereof; and it shall be lawful for the said parties of the second part, its executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter, to take possession of the said premises and all the improvements thereon, and receive the rents, issues and profits thereof, and to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, and out of all moneys arising from such sale, to retain the amount then unpaid of principal and interest, together with the costs and charges of making such sale, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the parties making such sale, on demand, to the said first parties or their heirs and assigns.
