AGREEMENT

AGREEMENT MADE this 20th day of February 1933, by and between Earl D. Hay and Bessie L. Hay, his wife of Lawrence, Kansas parties of the first part, and THE EQUITABLE LIFE ASSURANCE SOCIETY OF THE UNITED STATES, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of New York, and having its principal office in the Borough of Manhattan of the City of New York, party of the second part, WITNESSETH:
