the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey, unto said party of the second part, its successors and
assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, to-wit:Begin at a point Eighty (80) feet south of the Southeast corner of Block Eighteen (18)
in Lane Place Addition, thence running south One Hundred (100) feet thence west One
hundred twenty five (125) feet thence North One Hundred (100) feet; thence East One
Hundred Twenty-five (125) feet to place of beginning, all in the city of Lawrence,
Kansas.TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular, the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in
anywise appertaining, forever.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, And this instrument is executed and delivered to secure the payment of the sum of

Four Hundred Fifty and 100/100 DOLLARS,
with interest thereon, and such fines and charges as may become due to said party of second part under the terms and conditions of the contract note secured
hereby, advanced by the said Lawrence Building and Loan Association to the part 1st of the
first part upon 4 1/2 shares of Class G of the capital stock of said Association, evidenced by Certificate No. 1719, which said shares
have been assigned to said Association with all the future payments, earnings and dividends thereon, which said interest and dues on said shares, the first part 1st
