 hereby, advanced by the said The Lawrence Building and Loan Association to the parties of the
 first part upon 21 shares of Class G of the capital stock of said Association, evidenced by Certificate No. 1736, which said shares
 have been assigned to said Association with all the future payments, earnings and dividend thereon, which said interest and dues on said shares, the first parties
