The Mortgagor covenants and agrees as follows:

- 1. That, together with and in addition to, the monthly payments of principal and interest payable under the terms of the note secured hereby, the Mortgagor will pay to the Mortgagoe until the said note is fully paid, the following sums:
 - (a) If this mortgage and the note secured hereby are insured under the provisions of the National Housing Act and so long as they con-
 - (b) A sum equal to one-twelfth (1/12) of one-half of one per centum (½%) of the amount of principal then remaining unpaid under the said note as a service charge, which sum is more particularly to cover the expenses of handling the monthly payments on account of taxes, assessments, and fire and other hazard insurance hereinafter provided for, and to cover the other servicing costs in connection with this mortgage and the note secured hereby.
 - (c) An installment of the taxes and assessments levied or to be levied against the premises covered by this mortgage; and an installment of the premium or premiums that will become due and payable to renw the insurance on the premises covered hereby against less by five or such other hazard as may reasonably be required by the Mortgage in amounts and in a consistency or companies satisfactors and taxes and assessments next due (as estimated by the Mortgagee), less all timeline premium or premium for such insurance, and taxes and assessments next due (as estimated by the Mortgagee), less all timeline premium and taxes and assessments will become due. The Mortgagee shall hold the monthly payments in trust to pay such premium or premiums and taxes, and assessments when due.

(II) service charge as set forth in subsection (b) above; (III) taxes, assessments, fire and other hazard insurance premiums; (IV) interest on the note secured hereby; and (V) amortization of the principal of said note.

Any deficiency in the amount of such aggregate monthly payment shall, unless made good by the Mortgagor prior to the due date of the next such payment, constitute an event of default under this mortgage.

- 2. - 5. That if the premises covered hereby, or any part thereof, shall be damaged by fire or other hazard against which insurance is held as hereinhefore provided, the amounts paid by any insurance company pursuant to the contract of insurance shall, to the extent of the indebtedness then remaining unpaid, be paid to the Mortgagee, and, at its option, may be applied to the debt or released for the repairing or rebuilding of the premises.
- 6. That if the Mortgagor falls to make any payment provided for in this mortgage for taxes, insurance premiums, repair of the premises, or the like, then the Mortgagee may pay the same and all sums so advanced, with interest thereof at six per centum (6%) per annum from the date of such advance, shall be payable on demand and shall be secured hereby.
- 7. That if there shall be a default in any of the terms, conditions or covenants of this mortgage, or of the note secured hereby, then any sums owing by the Mortgager to the Mortgagee shall, at the option of the Mortgagee, become immediately due and payable. The Mortgagee shall then have the right to enter into the possession of the mortgaged premises and collect the rents, issues and profits thereof. In the event of any default, as herein described, this mortgage may be foreclosed. Appraisement is hereby waived.
