THIS MORTGAGE, made the first day of March, A.D. 1935, Between EMBETT F. BARRETT and MINNIE L. BARRETT, his wife, of the County of Jackson, and State of Missouri, parties of the first part, and THE PRUDENTIAL INSURANCE COMPANY OF AMERICA, a body corporate, existing under and by virtue of the laws of New Jersey, and having its chief office in the City of Newark, New Jersey, party of the second part.

WITNESSETH: That whereas the said parties of the first part are justly indebted to the said THE PRUDENTIAL INSURANCE COMPANY OF AMERICA for money borrowed in the sum of FOUR THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED and No/100 - - - DOLLARS, to secure the payment of which they have executed their promissory note, of even date herewith, for FOUR THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED and No/100 - - - Dollars, payable in - - - annual payments, the first payment of ONE HUNDRED and No/100 - - - Dollars being payable on the first day of March, 1935, and a like amount being payable - - - annually thereafter, and the final payment, which shall be for the full amount of the balance due on said note, being payable on the first day of March, 1940, which said sum of FOUR THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED and No/100 - - - Dollars bears interest at the rate of five and one-half per cent. per annum; payable semi-annually, on the first day of March and September of each year.
