EXTENSION AGREEMENT

Lawrence, Kansas, August 30, 1935.

The undersigned hereby covenants that he is the legal owner of the premises conveyed to The Merchant Loan & Savings Bank, by a Mortgage, dated March 1, 1929 made by Wilfred E. Martin & Ravenna B.
