EXTENSION AGREEMENT

Topeka, Kansas, October 11, 1935

The undersigned hereby covenant that they are the legal owners of the premises conveyed to The National Reserve Life Insurance Co. by a Mortgage dated October 15, 1930 made by Minnie Seale, a widow, Henry G. Seale & wife Hulda, Mary Hunsinger & husband Geo. W., Louise Schulmeyer & husband P.
