KANSAS INSTALLMENT MORTGAGE

THIS MORTGAGE, made the first day of October, A.D. 1935, Between RACHEL WHITE, a widow; and EARL W. WHITE and NELLIE M. WHITE, his wife, of the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, parties of the first part, and THE PRUDENTIAL INSURANCE COMPANY OF AMERICA, a body corporate, existing under and by virtue of the laws of New Jersey and having its chief office in the City of Newark, State of New Jersey, party of the second part,

WITNESSETH: That whereas the said parties of the first part are justly indebted to the said - THE PRUDENTIAL INSURANCE COMPANY OF AMERICA - for money borrowed in the sum of TWO THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED & NO/100 -- (\$2,900.00) DOLLARS, to secure the payment of which they have executed their promissory note, of even date herewith, for TWO THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED & NO/100 -- (\$2,900.00) Dollars, payable in annual payments, the first payment of SEVENTY & NO/100 -- (\$70.00) Dollars being payable on the first day of October, 1936, and a like amount being payable - annually thereafter, and the final payment, which shall be for the full amount of the balance due on said note, being payable on the first day of October, 1940, which said sum of TWO THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED & NO/100 ---- (\$2,900.00) Dollars bears interest at the rate of five (5) per cent. per annum, payable - annually, on the first day of October of each year.

Said note provides that if any part of the principal or interest is not paid when due, all of the unpaid principal and interest then accrued shall thereafter bear interest at the rate of ten per cent, per annum, payable annually until paid, and said note is made payable to the order of said - THE PRUDENTIAL INSURANCE COMPANY OF AMERICA - at its office in Newark, New Jersey, in lawful money of the United States of America.
