EXTENSION AGREEMENT

Topeka, Kansas, March 25, 1936

The undersigned hereby covenant that we are the legal owners of the premises conveyed to The National Reserve Life Insurance Co. by a Mortgage, dated March 9, 1931 made by Margaret H. Miller (single) and Ruby E. Alcorn and M. D. Alcorn, her husband, and duly recorded in Douglas County, Kansas, Book 77, on page 280, to....., which Mortgage was given to secure the payment of a note or bond for the sum of \$3500.00, payable Mar. 15 1936, to The National Reserve Life Insurance Company or order, upon which note or bond there remains unpaid the sum of \$2800.00; of principal money; and in consideration of the extension of the time for the payment thereof for the term of five years from maturity, hereby agrees to assume said indebtedness and to pay interest upon said principal sum, from the day whereon the same, by the terms of said note or bond, becomes due, at the rate of six per cent per annum, payable semi-annually, for and during said term of extension, according to the tenor and effect of the extension coupons hereto attached, both principal and interest to be paid, when due, at the Home Office of The National Reserve Life Insurance Company, Topeka, Kansas; and in case of default in payment of any of said extension coupons, or in case of non-payment of taxes or breach of any of the covenants contained in said mortgage, it shall be optional with the legal holder or holders of said principal note to declare said principal sum immediately due and payable.
