EXTENSION AGREEMENT

Lawrence, Kansas, May 26, 1936.

The undersigned hereby covenant that they are the legal owners of the premises conveyed to The First Savings Bank of Lawrence, Kansas, by a Mortgage, dated September 1, 1932, made by W. L. Kuhn and Louise M.
