WITNESSETH That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred and no/100 DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, in the said and by the indenture do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Mortgage to the said party of the second part, the following described real estate situated and being in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, to-wit:

WITNESSETH, That the said part of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Twenty which is hereby acknowledged, following described real estate

with the appurtenances and all the estates, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein.
And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof, they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and intend of a good and sufficient estate & inheritance therein, free and clear of all encumbrance.

and that they will warrant and defend the same against all parties making lawful claim theron.

It is agreed between the parties herein that the part, legat, of the first part shall at all times during the life of this indenture, pay all taxes or assessments that may be levied or assessed against said real estate when the same become due and payable, and that, they, keep the buildings upon said real estate insured against fire and damage in such sum and by such insurance company as shall be specified and directed by the part, legat, of the second part, the sum, I say, made payable to the part, legat, of the second part to the extent of its interest. And in the event that said part, legat, of the first part shall fail to pay such taxes when the same become due and payable and to keep said premises insured as herein provided, then the part, legat, of the second part may pay said taxes and insurance, or either, and the amount so paid shall become a part of the indebtedness, secured by this indenture, and that bear interest at the rate of 1% from the date of payment until fully paid.THIS GRANT is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Seven Hundred and no/100 DOLLARS,according to the terms of this certain written obligation, for the payment of said sum of money, executed on the 24th day of November 1934, and by C. C. Winsler terms made payable to the part, legat, of the second part, with all interest accrued thereon according to the terms of said obligation and also to secure any sum or sums of money advanced by the said part, legat, of the second part to pay for any insurance or to discharge any taxes with interest thereon as herein provided, in the event that said part, legat, of the first part

shall fail to pay the same as provided in this indenture.

In the consideration what if the said obligations be found to have been discharged, and the obligations contained therein fully discharged. If default be made in such payment or any part thereof or any obligation contained therein, or if the taxes or said real estate are not paid when the same become due and payable, or if the buildings upon said real estate are destroyed, and the whole sum remaining unpaid, and all of the obligations contained in this indenture, the property of which the indenture is given, shall immediately mature and become due and payable at the option of the holder hereof, without notice, and it shall be lawful for the part, legat, of the second part,to take possession of the said premises and all the improvements thereon, and to have a receiver appointed to collect the rents and benefits accruing thereon, and to sell the premises hereby granted, and to apply the proceeds of such sale, together with the costs and charges incident thereto, and the expense of any prescribed by law and out of all moneys arising from such sale to retain the amount then due and of principal and interest, and to pay the same to the holder hereof, and the rest to be paid by the part, legat.

It is agreed by the parties herein that the term and payment of the principal sum and every obligation therein contained, and all benefits accruing thereon shall extend and last to, and be obligated upon the death, insolvency, bankruptcy, representation, marriage and separation of the respective parties herein.
