THIS INDENTURE, Made this 20th day of August, in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and Thirty-eight, between Milton Cleaver Elliott, and Maria Jane Elliott, his Wife

d. Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas
 parties of the first part, and The Lawrence National Bank, Lawrence, Kansas

WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Twelve Hundred & No/100 DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt of following described real estate situated and being in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, to-wit:

The Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4) of Section Thirty-six (36), Township Twelve (12), Range Eighteen (18) except one and one-fourth (1 1/4) acres for school site as shown by deed recorded in Deed Book O, Page 241, in the Office of the Register of Deeds of Douglas County, Kansas,

with the appurtenances and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein.

And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owner(s) of the premises above granted, and intend a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance theria, free and clear, of all incumbrances.

and that they will warrant and defend the same against all parties making lawful claim thereto.

It is agreed between the parties hereto that the party of the first part shall at all times during the life of this Indenture, pay all taxes or assessments that may be levied or assessed against said real estate when the same becomes due and payable, and that they will keep the buildings upon said real estate insured against fire and tornado in such sum and by an insurance company as shall be specified and directed by the party of the second part, the less, if any, made payable to the party of the second part to the extent of its interest. And in the event that said party of the first part shall fail to pay such taxes when the same become due and payable and to keep said premises insured as herein provided, then the party of the second part may pay all taxes and insurance, or either, and the amount so paid shall become a part of the indebtedness, secured by this Indenture, and shall bear interest at the rate of 10% from the date of payment until paid.

THIS GRANT is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Twelve Hundred & No/100 DOLLARS,

according to the terms of one certain written obligation for the payment of said sum of money, executed on the 20th day of August, 1938, and by its terms made payable to the party of the second part, with all interest accrued thereon according to the terms of said obligation and also to secure any sum or sums of money advanced by the said party of the second part to pay for any taxes or to discharge any taxes with interest thereon as herein provided, in the event that said parties of the first part

fail to pay the same as provided in this Indenture.

And that conveyance shall be void if such payment be made as herein specified, and the obligation contained herein fully discharged. If default be made in such payments or any part thereof or any obligation created thereby, or interest thereon, or if the taxes on said real estate are not paid when the same become due and payable, or if the insurance is not kept up, as provided herein, or if the buildings upon said real estate are not repaired as they now are, or if waste is committed on said premises, then this instrument becomes absolute and the property hereinabove described is given, as soon as possible, to the holder hereof, and all of the obligations provided for in a writing otherwise, for the payment of which this Indenture is given, that immediately after and before due and payable at the option of the holder hereof, without notice, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part, to take possession of the said premises and all the improvements thereon by law and out of all money arising from such sale to retain the amount then unpaid of principal and interest, together with the costs and charges incident thereto, and the overplus, if any due, shall be paid by the party of the second part, making such sale, on demand, to the first party.

And it is further agreed that the terms and provisions of this Indenture and each and every obligation therein contained, and all benefits accruing therefrom shall extend and have effect to, and be obligatory upon the heirs, executors, administrators, personal representatives, assigns and successors of the respective parties hereto.
