

DOUGLAS COUNTY

Item 4. The 33,000 volt single circuit wood pole transmission line running from the Company's plant in the City of Emporia, Lyon County, easterly through the Counties of Lyon and Coffey to the City of Waverly in Coffey County.

Item 5. The 33,000 volt single circuit wood pole transmission line running from the Company's plant in the City of Emporia, Lyon County, northwesterly through the Counties of Lyon and Morris to the City of Council Grove in Morris County.

Item 6. The 33,000 volt single circuit wood pole transmission line running from the Company's plant in the City of Emporia, Lyon County, southwesterly through the Counties of Lyon and Chase to the City of Cottonwood Falls in Chase County.

Item 7. The 33,000 volt loop circuit wood pole transmission line running from the Company's plant in the City of Emporia southerly through the Counties of Lyon and Greenwood to the Company's oil field substation known as Vaughn in Greenwood County; said loop circuit being composed of two single circuits of one mile separation.

Item 8. The 33,000 volt single circuit wood pole transmission line running from the Company's Vaughn oil field substation easterly to Madison and thence southerly to Hamilton, all in the County of Greenwood.

Item 9. The 33,000 volt single circuit wood pole transmission line running easterly from Hamilton to Virgil, all in the County of Greenwood, thence southerly through the Counties of Greenwood and Woodson to Toronto in Woodson County.

Item 10. The 33,000 volt single circuit wood pole transmission line running southwesterly from the City of Hamilton to the City of Eureka, all in the County of Greenwood.

(B) All and singular the electric plants, substations, distribution lines, and systems, and all transmission lines of the Company located in or in the vicinity of the following cities, municipalities, villages and communities in the State of Kansas, to-wit:

(D) All and singular the gas plants, transmission mains and distribution mains and systems of the Company in the State of Kansas located in or in the vicinity of the City of Emporia in Lyon County and the City of Leavenworth in Leavenworth County.

(E) All and singular the ice manufacturing plants of the Company in the City of Eureka, in Greenwood County and in the City of Council Grove in Morris County, all in the State of Kansas.

(F) All and singular the motor buses, motor trucks and motor vehicles owned by the Company, together with all machinery, tools and equipment of the Company used or useful in connection with the operation thereof.
