RELEASE OF MORTGAGE

For and in consideration of the sum of one dollar and other valuable consideration, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the LAND BANK COMMISSIONER, with offices in the City of Wichita, Kansas, acting pursuant to Part 3 of the Act of Congress known as the Emergency Farm Mortgage Act of 1933, hereby releases, discharges and cancels the following described mortgage, to-wit:

Dated February 1, 1934, executed by William Henry Hornberger (also known as William H. Hornberger) and Lena Hornberger, his wife, as mortgagor (s), in favor of said Commissioner as mortgagee, securing a note for \$1,600.00 recorded in Book 79, Page 105 of the records of mortgages of Douglas County, State of Kansas, and covering the following described land situated in said County, to-wit:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Northwest Quarter (NW¹/₄) of Section Twenty (20), Township Fourteen (14) South, Range Nineteen (19) East, of the Sixth Principal Meridian.
