MORTGAGE EXTENSION AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, on the 11th day of October, 1934, Glenn Carter and Blanch Carter executed and delivered a certain mortgage to THE STANDARD LIFE ASSOCIATION, which said mortgage was recorded in book 82, page 11 of the mortgage records of Douglas county, State of Kansas, to secure the payment of a note dated Oct. 11th, 1934, due October 15th, 1937, in the principle sum of \$2,500.00, with interest at the rate of 5 per cent., payable semi-annually on the 15th days of April and October; and

WHEREAS, the undersigned, J.C. Porter and Grace E. Porter, his wife, hereby covenant that they are the present legal owners of the premises described in said mortgage recorded as aforesaid, to which reference is hereby made for particular description of said property, and the undersigned do hereby agree that there remains a balance due and unpaid on said indebtedness in the amount of \$2,500.00, represented by the above described note and mortgage; and

WHEREAS, THE STANDARD LIFE ASSOCIATION of Lawrence, Kansas is the present owner and holder of the note representing the unpaid balance due on said indebtedness and the mortgage securing the same, and, upon the application of the obligors hereinbefore named, has consented that time of payment of said note and mortgage may be extended upon the conditions hereinafter set forth.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the extension of time for the payment of said indebtedness the undersigned covenant and agree to pay the said indebtedness on or before the 15th day of October, 1942, together with interest thereon at the rate of 5 per cent. per annum, payable semi-annually on the 15th days of April and October in each calendar year; principal and interest to be payable at Lawrence, Kansas, and in the event the principal sum or any interest be not paid when due, then said principal sum or any part thereof not paid when due or demandable and all interest due and unpaid shall
