SATISFACTION OF MORTGAGE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS THAT:

WHEREAS, Peoples Utilities Kansas Corporation, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware, executed and delivered to Peoples Trust and Savings Bank and A. L. Warner as Trustees, a certain Indenture of Mortgage (hereinafter called the "Mortgage"), dated January 1, 1927, to secure an issue of First Mortgage Gold Bonds, which Mortgage was duly recorded with the Register of Deeds of Douglas County, Kansas, on January 31, 1927, document No. 10083, in Volume 67, Page 492, and filed as a Chattel Mortgage, document No. 174, in Volume "X", Page 162; and

WHEREAS, in April, 1927, Peoples Trust and Savings Bank and A. L. Warner duly resigned as Trustees under the Mortgage and The Seaboard National Bank of The City of New York and John A. Burns were, in the manner provided in the Mortgage, duly designated and appointed as Trustees under the Mortgage to succeed Peoples Trust and Savings Bank and A. L. Warner, resigned, and duly accepted the appointments as successor Trustees under the Mortgage; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the request of The Seaboard National Bank of The City of New York and John A. Burns, as successor Trustees as aforesaid, Peoples Trust and Savings Bank and A. L. Warner and Peoples Utilities Kansas Corporation executed and delivered to The Seaboard National Bank of The City of New York and John A. Burns, as successor Trustees as aforesaid, a confirmatory deed dated April 29, 1927, conveying and transferring unto the successor Trustees all the respective rights, title and interests of Peoples Trust and Savings Bank and A. L. Warner and Peoples Utilities Kansas Corporation under the Mortgage and in and to the property and assets described therein, which confirmatory deed was duly recorded with the Register of Deeds of Douglas County, Kansas, on May 25, 1927, in Volume 67, at Pages 608 to 612, inclusive, and filed as a Chattel Mortgage, in Volume "X", Page 171; and

WHEREAS, on June 18, 1929, The Seaboard National Bank of The City of New York was duly converted into the Seaboard Bank of The City of New York, and thereafter, on September 18, 1929, said The Seaboard Bank of The City of New York was duly merged into The Equitable Trust Company of New York, and thereafter, on May 31, 1930, said The Equitable Trust Company of New York was duly consolidated with The Chase National Bank of The City of New York, by virtue of which conversion, merger and consolidation The Chase National Bank of The City of New York is now the duly qualified and acting successor to said The Seaboard National Bank of The City of New York as one of the successor Trustees as aforesaid; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgage has been paid and satisfied:
