ASSIGNMENT OF MORTGAGE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

WHEREAS, The Kaw Valley Electric Cooperative Company, Inc., a cooperative corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Kansas, as Mortgagor, executed and delivered to United States of America, as Mortgagee, a certain Mortgage, dated as of October 1, 1937, to secure a note (hereinafter called the "Mortgage Note"), of even date therewith, in the principal amount of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000), payable to the order of United States of America;

NOW, THEREFORE, United States of America, acting through the Administrator of the Rural Electrification Administration (hereinafter called the "Administrator") appointed pursuant to the Rural Electrification Act of 1936 (hereinafter called the "Act"), in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) and of sums advanced and to be advanced pursuant to the provisions of the Act by Reconstruction Finance Corporation to the Administrator, does hereby grant, bargain, sell, assign, transfer and set over unto Reconstruction Finance Corporation, Washington, D.C., its successors and assigns, all right, title and interest of the Mortgage in, to and under said Mortgage and all the property therein mentioned, described or referred to as being mortgaged thereby, together with the Mortgage Note and the money due and to become due thereon with interest.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto said Reconstruction Finance Corporation, its successors and assigns forever.

This assignment may be simultaneously executed in any number of counterparts, and all said counterparts executed and delivered, each as an original, shall constitute but one and the same instrument.
