## ASSIGNMENT OF MORTGAGE

A certain mortgage (hereinafter called the "Mortgage"), dated as of October 1, 1937, executed and delivered by the Kaw Valley Electric Cooperative Company, Inc. (hereinafter called the "Mortgagor") to the Government, made to secure notes of the Mortgagor, including the Outstanding Notes, issued in accordance with the terms of the Mortgage, the aggregate principal amount of which shall not exceed \$1,000,000.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the Government, its successors and assigns forever.

This assignment may be simultaneously executed in any number of counterparts, and all said counterparts executed and delivered, each as an original, shall constitute but one and the same instrument.
