

Anderson County, WELDA: Main line station pumping into Kansas City, Nos. 1 and 2, 16" lines, located on lands described in Parcels 16 and 17 and more particularly described under Fee Properties above described.

Chase County, MATFIELD GREEN: Main line station—Wichita-Ottawa 20" line, located on a leasehold covering NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 28, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 29, all in Twp. 22 S., R 8 E., Recorded in Book K Misc. pp. 349-50.
