

A combination 6", 8", 10" and 12" lateral line extending in a northwesterly direction from Tallant Station through Osage County, Oklahoma serving Pawhuska, Oklahoma, and continuing in a westerly and southwesterly direction to Ponca City in Kay County, Oklahoma, said line totaling 5.6 miles of 12" pipe, 10.4 miles of 10" pipe, 21.5 miles of 8" pipe, 4.8 miles of 6" pipe, 1.0 miles of 5" pipe, 3.4 miles of 4" pipe, 2.2 miles of 3" pipe, and 4.5 miles of 2" pipe, all in Osage County, Oklahoma, and 20.7 miles of 6" pipe in Kay County, Oklahoma.

TALLANT COMPRESSOR STATION TO COTTON VALLEY MEASURING STATION.

An 18" pipeline extending from the Tallant Compressor Station in Osage County, Oklahoma to the Cotton Valley measuring station in Washington County, Oklahoma, said line being more specifically described as follows:

Beginning at the Tallant Compressor Station, as previously described, a single 18" line extends northeast to the Washington County, Oklahoma line, said line totaling 17.6 miles of 18" pipe, a multiple river crossing of 0.3 miles of 10" pipe and miscellaneous gathering lines consisting of 3.0 miles of 2" pipe, in Osage County, Oklahoma;

Thence continuing with a single 18" line to the Cotton Valley Measuring Station in Section 24, T. 29 N, R. 13 E, Washington County, Oklahoma, said line totaling 14 miles of 18" pipe in Washington County, Oklahoma;

Also a 6" lateral extending from the above described line to the Dewey Cement Plant, said line totaling 3.7 miles of 6" pipe in Washington County, Oklahoma.

A combination 12", 16", and 18" pipeline extending from the Tallant Compressor Station in Osage County, Oklahoma, in an easterly direction into Washington County, Oklahoma, and in a northerly direction to the Cotton Valley Measuring Station in Washington County, Oklahoma, and being more specifically described as follows:

Beginning at the previously described Tallant Compressor Station in Osage County, Oklahoma, a single 16" line extends 4.8 miles east changing in size to a 12" line and continuing 5.8 miles east to the Washington
