

County line, with miscellaneous gathering lines consisting of 1.2 miles of 2" pipe in Osage County, Oklahoma;

Thence continuing east in Washington County, Oklahoma, with a single 12" line 8.6 miles; thence north with a single 12" line 4.9 miles, changing in size to a single 18" and continuing north 21.2 miles to the previously described Cotton Valley measuring station, said line totaling 13.5 miles of 12" pipe, 21.2 miles of 18" pipe, and miscellaneous gathering lines consisting of 1.0 miles of 4", and 1.5 miles of 2" pipe, all in Washington County, Oklahoma;

A combination 8" and 6" single lateral line extending from the above described line to Bartlesville in Washington County, Oklahoma, serving also Dewey in Washington County, Oklahoma, with a 5" lateral north from the first described lateral, said lines totaling 1.0 miles of 5" pipe, 2.3 miles of 4" pipe, 3.7 miles of 6" pipe, and 3.0 miles of 8" pipe, all in Washington County, Oklahoma;

A single 6" line extending east from the above described main 18" line in Washington County, Oklahoma to Nowata and Delaware in Nowata County, Oklahoma, said line totaling 2.0 miles of 6" pipe in Washington County, Oklahoma; 10.6 miles of 6" pipe, 3.9 miles of 4" pipe, and 1.2 miles of 3" pipe, all in Nowata County, Oklahoma.

#### COTTON VALLEY MEASURING STATION TO SPRINGFIELD, MISSOURI.

A combination 16" and 10" pipeline extending from the Cotton Valley Measuring Station in Washington County, Oklahoma east to Springfield in Greene County, Missouri and passing through Washington, Nowata, Craig and Ottawa Counties, Oklahoma, and Cherokee County, Kansas, and Newton, Lawrence, Christian and Greene Counties, Missouri, and being more specifically described as follows:

Beginning at the previously described Cotton Valley Measuring Station in Washington County, Oklahoma, a single 16" line extends southeast to the Nowata County, Oklahoma line, said line totaling 3.5 miles of 16" pipe in Washington County, Oklahoma;

Thence continuing east through Nowata County with a single 16" line to the Craig County, Oklahoma line, said line totaling 21.6 miles of 16" pipe in Nowata
