

Kansas line, said line totaling 12.5 miles of 16" pipe, and a multiple river crossing constituting of 0.2 miles of 12" pipe in Montgomery County, Kansas;

Thence continuing east through Labette County, Kansas, with a single 16" line to the Cherokee County, Kansas line, said line totaling 25.6 miles of 16" pipe, and a multiple river crossing consisting of 0.2 miles of 10" pipe in Labette County, Kansas;

Also an 8" lateral extending north passing Altamont Compressor Station in Sec. 19, T. 33 S., R. 19 E., Labette County, Kansas, passing Mound Valley compressor station in Sec. 31, T. 32 S., R. 19 E., near Mound Valley in Labette county, Kansas, and continuing northeast to Parsons in Labette County, Kansas, said line totaling 14.3 miles of 8" pipe, with miscellaneous gathering lines of 2.0 miles of 6" pipe, 1.0 miles of 5" pipe, 4.2 miles of 3" pipe, and 2.5 miles of 2" pipe, and 2.5 miles of 4" pipe, in Labette County, Kansas;

Also an 8" lateral extending south from the above 16" line, being an extension of the above described 8" lateral, into Craig County, Oklahoma, consisting of 10.3 miles of 8" pipe in Labette County, Kansas, and 4.1 miles of 8" pipe in Craig County, Oklahoma;

Also a 4" lateral extending north to Altamont in Labette County, Kansas, said line totaling 2.5 miles of 4" pipe in Labette County, Kansas;

Also a 4" lateral to Oswego in Labette County, Kansas, said line totaling 0.8 miles more or less of 4" pipe in Labette County, Kansas;

Thence continuing east through Cherokee County, Kansas with a single 16" line to the Kansas-Missouri State Line, said line totaling 25.1 miles more or less of 16" pipe in Cherokee County, Kansas;

Also a 6" lateral extending north to Columbus in Cherokee County, Kansas; said line totaling 0.7 miles of 6" pipe in Cherokee County, Kansas;

Also a combination 10" and 6" lateral extending north passing Seammon and Weir to a point near Cherokee in Crawford County, Kansas, continuing northeast to Pittsburg in Crawford County, Kansas, and continuing with a 4" line to Girard in Crawford County, Kansas, said line totaling 13.8 miles of 10" pipe, 0.2 miles of 8" pipe, 1.0 miles of 5" pipe, 1.0 miles of 4" pipe, and 2.1 miles of 3" pipe in Cherokee County, Kansas, and 6.7 miles of 10" pipe, 4.2 miles of 6" pipe, 0.4 miles of 5" pipe, and 7.9 miles of 4" pipe in Crawford County, Kansas;
