

Princeton and Richmond in Franklin County, said lines totaling 3.6 miles of 2" pipe in Franklin County, Kansas.

OTTAWA MEASURING STATION TO SEDALIA.

A 12" pipeline extending from the Ottawa Measuring Station in Franklin County, Kansas to Springfield in Pettis County, Missouri, passing through Franklin and Miami counties, Kansas, and Cass, Johnson and Pettis Counties, Missouri, with laterals extending into Johnson, Lafayette, Saline and Carroll Counties, Missouri, and being more specifically described as follows:

Beginning at the Ottawa Measuring Station as previously described in Franklin County, Kansas, a single 12" line extends east to the Miami County, Kansas line, said line totaling 9.0 miles of 12" pipeline in Franklin County, Kansas;

Thence continuing east through Miami County, Kansas, with a single 12" line to the Kansas-Missouri State line, said line totaling 24.8 miles of 12" pipe in Miami County, Kansas;

Thence continuing east across Cass County, Missouri to the Johnson County line with a single 12" pipeline totaling 26.5 miles of 12" pipe in Cass County, Missouri;

Thence continuing east across Johnson County, Missouri, with a single 12" line to the Pettis County, Missouri line, said line totaling 33.8 miles of 12" pipe in Johnson County, Missouri;

Also a short 4" lateral extending north to Warrensburg in Johnson County, Missouri, said line totaling 1.5 miles of 4" line in Johnson County, Missouri;

Also an 8" lateral, known as the Carrollton lateral, extending north through Johnson County, Lafayette County and to Carrollton in Carroll County, Missouri, with laterals to Knobnoster in Johnson County, Concordia and Waverly in Lafayette County, Missouri, said lines totaling 1.1 mile of 3" pipe, and 14.0 miles of 8" pipe in Johnson County, Missouri; 1.7 miles of 3" pipe and 20.0 miles more or less of 8" pipe in Lafayette County, Missouri, and 10.2 miles of 8" pipe in Carroll County, Missouri; also a 3" lateral extending east from the Carrollton lateral through Lafayette County into Saline County, Missouri, serving Emma and Sweet Springs in said Saline County, said line totaling 2.0
