Thence continuing east with a single $12^{\prime\prime}$ line to Sedalia in Pettis County, Missouri, said line totaling 16.2 miles of 12^{''} pie and 0.3 miles of 8^{''} pie in Pettis County, Missouri, also a 2^{''} Interal extending north to Lamonte in Pettis County, Missouri, said line totaling 2.9 miles of 2^{''} pipe in Pettis County, Missouri.

OTTAWA MEASURING STATION TO GLAVIN MEASURING STATION.

(Glavin located just outside the Greater Kansas City area)

A looped 16" pipeline extending from the Ottawa measuring station in Franklin County, Kansas to Glavin Measuring Station in Johnson County, Kansas, passing through Franklin, Douglas and Johnson Counties, Kansas, with laterals and field lines in Franklin, Johnson and Wyandotte Counties, Kansas, and being more specifically described as follows:

Beginning at the Ottawa measuring station as previously described in Franklin County, Kansas, three 16" lines extend northeast to the northeast corner of Franklin County on the Douglas County, Kansas line, said lines totaling 32.2 miles of 16" pipe in Franklin County, Kansas; also short lateral lines to Le Loup and Wellsville in Franklin County, Kansas, said lines totaling 1.1 miles of 2" pipe in Franklin County, Kansas;

Thence continuing northeast through Douglas County, Kansas with three 16" lines to the Johnson County, Kansas line, said line totaling 5.8 miles of 16" pipe in Douglas County, Kansas;
