

Kay in Oklahoma, and Sumner, Cowley, Elk and Wilson in Kansas, said system being more specifically described as follows:

Beginning at the Dilworth compressor station in Section 31, T. 29 N, R. 1 E, in Kay County, Oklahoma and running in a northeasterly direction to the Kansas-Oklahoma State line, said line totaling 4.5 miles of 16" pipe in Kay County, Oklahoma;

Thence continuing in a northeasterly direction to the Cowley County line, said line totaling 1.5 miles of 16" pipe in Sumner County;

Thence continuing in a northeasterly direction and passing through Cambridge Compressor Station to the Elk County line, said line totaling 36.5 miles of 16" pipe and 5.0 miles of 12" pipe, and a multiple river crossing of 0.5 miles of 10", and 0.3 miles of 12" pipe in Cowley County, Kansas;

Also a lateral line extending easterly to Arkansas City, and Kan-O-Tex Refinery, said line totaling 5.5 miles of 6" pipe in Cowley County, Kansas;

Also a 2" lateral line extending east and west from the above line in Sections 28 and 26, T. 34 S, R. 3 E, Cowley County, Kansas, said lines totaling 2.4 miles of 2" pipe in Cowley County, Kansas;

Also a lateral line extending south from the above line to Arkansas City, Kansas, said line totaling 0.7 miles of 10" pipe in Cowley County, Kansas;

Also a lateral line extending northwesterly from the above line to the Rainbow Bond field in Sec. 21, T. 33 S, R. 3 E, said line totaling 3.0 miles of 8" pipe and 3.2 miles of 6" pipe in Cowley County, Kansas;

Also a lateral line extending northerly from the above line to the Winfield field and to New Salem, said line totaling 5.3 miles of 10" pipe, 0.6 miles of 8" pipe, 1.0 mile of 6" pipe, 2.1 miles of 4" pipe, 5.1 miles of 3" pipe, and 1.5 miles of 2" pipe, in Cowley County, Kansas;

Also a lateral line extending in a southeasterly direction from the above line to Dexter, said line totaling 8.4 miles of 3" pipe in Cowley County, Kansas;

Also a lateral line extending north from the above line to Burden, said line totaling 0.7 miles of 3" pipe in Cowley County, Kansas;

Also a lateral line extending in a southeasterly direction from the above line to Cambridge, said line totaling 2.1 miles of 2" pipe in Cowley County, Kansas;
