

Thence continuing in a northeasterly direction passing Mooreland Compressor Station in Sec. 35, T. 24 N., R. 19 W., in Woodward County, Oklahoma, to the Woods County, Oklahoma line, said line totaling 36.4 miles of 20" pipe, and multiple river crossing of 2.4 miles of 12" pipe in Woodward County, Oklahoma;

Thence continuing in a northeasterly direction through Woods County to the Alfalfa County line, said line totaling 37.2 miles of 20" pipe and a multiple river crossing of 9.2 miles of 12" pipe in Woods County, Oklahoma;

Thence continuing in a northeasterly direction through Alfalfa County, Oklahoma to the Oklahoma-Kansas State line, said line totaling 9.1 miles of 20" pipe in Alfalfa County, Oklahoma;

Thence continuing in a northeasterly direction through Barber County, Kansas to the Harper County line, said line totaling 2.7 miles of 20" pipe and a multiple river crossing of 3.8 miles of 12" pipe in Barber County, Kansas;

Thence in a northeasterly direction passing Corwin Compressor Station in Sections 22 and 27, T. 34 S., R. 9 W., Harper County, Kansas to the Sumner County, Kansas line, said line totaling 35.9 miles of 20" pipe, and a multiple river crossing of 5.0 miles of 12" pipe in Harper County, Kansas;

Thence continuing in a northeasterly direction through Sumner County, Kansas to the Sedgwick County line, said line totaling 14.2 miles of 20" pipe in Sumner County, Kansas;

Thence continuing in a northeasterly direction to the Wichita Compressor Station in Sec. 17, T. 28 S., R. 1 E., Sedgwick County, Kansas, said line totaling 16.5 miles of 20" and a multiple river crossing of 1.0 mile of 12" pipe in Sedgwick County, Kansas;

Also a main gas gathering line composed of 20", 16", 12" pipe in the Texas Panhandle field extending in a westerly direction from the Pampa Compressor station through Gray and Carson Counties, Texas, said system being more specifically described as follows:

Beginning at the Pampa compressor station in Sec. 90, I. & G. N. R. R. Block 3 Gray County, Texas and running in a westerly direction to the Carson County line, said line with its field gathering lines and laterals
