Also a lateral line extending west from the above line to the Kansas Gas & Electric Company power plant in Sec. 29, T. 26 S., R. 1 E., said line totaling 1.0 mile of 8" pipe and 0.1 miles of 10" pipe in Sedgwick County, Kansas;

Also a lateral line extending from the above line in a northerly direction passing Bentley to Halstead in Harvey County, Kansas; said line totaling 1.9 miles of 4" pipe in Sedgwick County, Kansas, and 6.2 miles of 4" pipe in Harvey County, Kansas;

Thence continuing in a northwesterly direction to the Reno County line, said line totaling 7.0 miles of 10" pipe and 1.5 miles of 12" pipe in Harvey County, Kansas;

Also a lateral line extending from the above line south to Mt. Hope in Sedgwick County, Kansas, said line totaling 2.2 miles of 3" pipe in Harvey County, Kansas, and 2.5 miles of 3" pipe in Sedgwick County, Kansas;

Thence continuing in a northwesterly direction passing the Hutchinson compressor station to the Hutchinson town border station in Sec. 20, T. 23 S., R. 5 W., said line totaling 12.2 miles of 10" pipe in Reno County, Kansas.

AUGUSTA AND ELDORADO 6 INCH & S INCH.

A combination 6" and 8" line extending from the Caney-Wichita 12" in Butler County, Kansas, northeast to the Eldorado town border, with laterals extending to the Eldorado and Augusta fields and to Haverhill and Augusta town borders in Butler County, Kansas, more specifically described as follows:

Beginning at the Cotton Valley to Hutchinson 12" line in Sec. 1, T. 29 S., R. 3 E., Butler County, Kansas, a combination 6" and 8" line extending northeast to the Eldorado town border, Butler County, Kansas, said line totaling 13.4 miles of 6" pipe, and 8.4 miles of 8" pipe. Also, laterals extending to Haverhill and Augusta town borders, said laterals totaling 5.7 miles of 3" pipe, and 0.6 miles of 6" pipe in Butler County, Kansas. Also field gathering lines extending to the Augusta field, said lines totaling approximately 3.6 miles of 2" pipe, and 2.7 miles of 3" pipe, also field gathering lines extending to the Eldorado field, said lines totaling approximately 3.2 miles of 2" pipe, and 3.9 miles of 3" pipe, 4.4 miles of 4" pipe, 3.9 miles of 6" pipe, and 7.8 miles of 8" pipe, in Butler County, Kansas.
