WICHITA TO HUTCHINSON 10 INCH & 12 INCH.

A single combination 10" and 12" line extending from the Wichita Compressor Station in Sedgwick County, Kansas, northwest to the Hutchinson compressor station in Reno County, Kansas, and passing through Harvey County, Kansas, with laterals extending into Sedgwick, Harvey and Reno Counties, Kansas, being more specifically described as follows:

Beginning at the Wichita Compressor Station in Sec. 17, T. 28 S., R. 1 E., Sedgwick county, Kansae, a single combination 10" and 12" line extending west and northwesterly through Sedgwick County, Kansas to Harvey county line, said line totaling 18.6 miles of 10" pipe, and 8.0 miles of 12" pipe in Sedgwick county, Kansas;

Thence continuing northwesterly with a single 12" line through Reno County to the Burrton gasoline plant line, said line totaling 7.2 miles of 12" in Harvey county, Kansas;

Thence continuing northwesterly with a single 12" line through Reno county to the Burrton gasolene plant in Sec. 25, T. 23 S., R. 4 W., thence west with a single 10" line to the Hutchinson compressor station in Sec. 20, T. 23 S., R. 5 W., said lines totaling 1.8 miles of 12" pipe, and 9.2 miles of 10" pipe in Reno County, Kansas; Also a lateral extending to the town of Burrton in Harvey County, Kansas, said line totaling 2 miles of

2" pipe in Harvey County, Kansas;

Also field gathering lines in the Burrton field, Reno County, Kansas with a lateral extending to the town of New Haven from this gathering system, said lines totaling approximately 2.7 miles of 2" pipe, 3.9 miles of 3" pipe, 5.3 miles of 4" pipe, 13.4 miles of 6" pipe, and 6.9 miles of 8" pipe in Reno County, Kansas.

A combination single 12", 10", 8" and 6" line extending north from the Wichita compressor station in Sedgwick County, Kansas through Harvey County and into McPherson County, Kansas, with laterals extending into Sedgwick, Harvey and McPherson Counties, Kansas, are more specifically described as follows:
