TELEPHONE LINES.

All those telephone lines, together with the easements for constructing, maintaining, replacing and operating the same, including all structures, poles, wires, tools and appliances and other personal property used in connection therewith located in the States of Texas, Oklahoma and Kansas, generally described as follows:

(a) A telephone line extending in a westerly direction from Ponca City in Kay County, Oklahoma, to Pampa in Gray County, Texas, and to the gas field in Carson County, Texas, and passing through the counties of Kay, Grant, Alfalfa, Woods, Woodward and Ellis in Oklahoma, and Hemphill, Wheeler, Gray and Carson in Texas, with a branch line extending to the Corwin compressor station in Harper County, Kansas, said branch line passing through Alfalfa County, Oklahoma, and Harper County, Kansas, the total length of the main line and the branches being 367 miles.

(b) A telephone line extending from Cushing in Payne County, Oklahoma to the Grabham compressor station and Independence in Montgomery County, Kansas, and passing through the counties of Payne, Creek, Pawnee, Osage and Washington in Oklahoma and Montgomery in Kansas, with branches in Osage and
