

Washington Counties, Oklahoma, the total length of the main line and its branches being 151½ miles.

(c) A telephone line extending from a connection with line (b) in Washington County, Oklahoma, in a northwesterly direction to Eldorado in Butler County, Kansas, and passing through the counties of Washington in Oklahoma and Montgomery, Chautauqua, Elk, Cowley and Butler Counties in Kansas with branches to the Augusta and Eldorado oil fields in Butler County, Kansas, the total length of the main line and its branches being 145 miles.

(d) A telephone line extending from a point west of Douglas in Butler County, Kansas, to Wichita in Sedgwick County, Kansas, with a branch line extending to the Wichita compressor station in Sedgwick County, Kansas, the total length of the main line and its branches being 37 miles.
