(c) The Trustees shall be under no obligation to see to the delivery or payment to them, or either of them, of any obligations or evidences of indebtedness or other securities or cash required to be delivered or paid to them, or either of them, hereunder, except in those cases where it is specifically herein provided that such delivery or payment is a condition precedent to the granting of an application hereunder, or to see that any of the property hereby intended to be conveyed or assigned is properly and legally subjected to the lien hereof. The Trustees need not take any action to secure the conveyance to themselves, or either of them, of any property acquired by the Company after the date of the execution hereof, except in those cases where it is specifically herein provided that the delivery of a supplemental indenture or other instrument of conveyance is a condition precedent to the granting of an application hereunder.

(d) The Trustees shall be under no duty to procure or renew, or under any liability for the failure of the Company to procure or renew, insurance; nor shall the Trustees be responsible for the selection of any insurer.

(c) The Trustees shall be under no duty or liability in respect of any tax, assessment or other governmental charge which may be levied, assessed or imposed against the Company or the Trustees or either of them, or against the holders of the Bonds by reason of their interest in the Trust Estate, or against the Trust Estate, nor shall the Trustees be under any duty to pay or to see to the payment of any such tax or to take any notice of any assessment thereof or to give any notice thereof to the holders of the Bonds or to any other person.

(f) The Trustees shall be under no responsibility or duty with respect to the disposition of the Bonds or the application of the proceeds thereof or of any moneys paid to the Company under any of the provisions hereof.

(g) The Trustees may select and employ, in and about the execution of their duties hereunder, suitable ap-
