

Thence continuing northeasterly to a point on the Kansas State Line in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 18, T. 29 N., R. 13 E., a total of 4.13 miles of 16" pipe in Washington County, Oklahoma;

Thence continuing northerly to Caney-Wichita Compressor Station in Sec. 13, T. 35 S., R. 13 E. Montgomery County, Kansas a total of 0.09 miles of 16" pipe in Montgomery County, Kansas.

#### HUGOTON FIELD TO BLACKWELL COMPRESSOR STATION

A 26" pipeline approximately 230 miles in length extending from the Straight Compressor Station in Texas County, Oklahoma eastward to the Blackwell Compressor Station in Kay County, Oklahoma, and passing through the counties of Texas, Beaver, Harper, Woods, Alfalfa, Grant, and Kay in Oklahoma, being more specifically described as follows:

Beginning at the Straight Compressor Station in Sec. 28, T. 5 N., R. 15 E. CM., Texas County, Oklahoma and running in an easterly direction to the Beaver County line, said line totaling 27.79 miles of 26" pipe in Texas County, Oklahoma;

Thence continuing in an easterly direction through Beaver County to the Harper County line, said line totaling 52.30 miles of 26" pipe in Beaver County, Oklahoma;

Thence continuing in an easterly direction through Harper County to the Woods County line, said line totaling 37.58 miles of 26" pipe and a multiple crossing of the Cimarron River of 0.88 miles of 20" pipe in Harper County, Oklahoma;

Thence continuing in an easterly direction through Woods County to the Alfalfa County line, said line totaling 41.74 miles of 26" pipe and multiple crossings of the Cimarron and Salt Fork of the Arkansas rivers of 3.48 miles of 20" pipe in Woods County, Oklahoma;

Thence continuing in an easterly direction through Alfalfa County to the Grant County line, said line totaling 23.08 miles of 26" pipe and a multiple crossing of the Medicine Lodge River of 1.76 miles of 20" pipe in Alfalfa County, Oklahoma;

Thence continuing in an easterly direction through Grant County to the Kay County line, said line total-
