PERMITS FROM COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

Anderson County, Kansas.

A 6" water line along highway between Sections 1 & 2, T.22S., R.19E., and Sections 35 & 36, T.21S., R.19E., and along highway between SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 35, and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 34, T.21S., R.19E.

Johnson County, Kansas.

103 St. North to 71 Street and along S Side Sections 4, 3, 2, T.13S., R.25E.

A 3" & 4" pipeline along highway beginning at the SE Cor. of fractional Sec. 2, T.13S., R.25E., thence north and within 3 feet of the property fence line along the west side of State Line Road a distance of one mile.

Kingman County, Kansas.

To cross all highways with Wichita-Cunningham 12" pipeline, T.27S., Ranges 5, 6, 7, 8, 9W & Sections 25, 26, 27, 28, 29 & NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 30, R.10W.

Reno County, Kansas.

In SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 17, T.23S., R.5W.

Rice County, Kansas.

Between Sec's. 2, T.20S., R.5W., and 35, T.19S., R.5W.

Sedgwick County, Kansas.

To cross all highways with Wichita-Cunningham 12" pipeline in T.27 & 28S., Ranges 1, 2, 3, 4 West and in Sec. 18, T.23S., R.1E.; to cross drainage canal located approx. 1000' North of South line of Sec. 4, T.27S., R.1E.; an 18" pipeline in Sections 8, 15, 9, 16, 10 and 17, T.28S., R.1E.
